Years 5&6 - Young Voices Concert – 16th January 2025

We are very excited to announce that The Priors School will once again be giving our Year 5 and 6 pupils the opportunity to participate in a Young Voices concert in January 2025.

The Young Voices experience is not simply a children's choir concert, these are the largest children's choir concerts in the world. Choirs will perform alongside 5,000-8,000 other children as a single choir to capacity audiences of family and friends. We are very excited to perform at the Resorts World Arena in Birmingham on **Thursday 16th January 2025**.

Children taking part in YV have the opportunity to perform in some of the world's greatest arenas alongside incredible artists. To achieve this with all their school friends around them for support, it helps their self-belief, self-motivation, confidence, and ability to communicate as part of a team - which is invaluable!

The concert is the culmination of a lot of hard work from teachers and children. We provide online resources called the YV music room so that children can practice at home to support the rehearsals they are doing in school. The songs are selected from a wide range of music styles to give the children the widest learning experience possible.

Participation in the Young Voices experience is FREE to all children in Owls. If parents and carers would like to attend the amazing event on 16th January, tickets are available to purchase – please see the form attached. We will need to ticket forms completed by **Monday 23rd September** so that we can ensure that The Priors School supporters are seated together.

In addition, you can order a Young Voices t-shirt pack, which includes a t-shirt and wristband. The children will be able to wear their t-shirt and wave their torch at concert. The t-shirt orders must also be received by the school by the **Monday 23rd September**. The t-shirts are not compulsory; children are able to wear a plain white t-shirt on the day if preferable.

Once your ticket and/or t-shirt orders have been received, the payment item will be added to your ParentPay account.

By submitting your consent, you are also committing to your child learning the songs so they are prepared for the concert: we will be practicing in school, but home learning will be essential so that they can enjoy the experience to the full.
