After School Club

Flu and Norovirus Awareness

Over the past couple of weeks there has been a rise in norovirus for children, otherwise known as the vomiting bug. Flu is also steadily increasing week-on week too.

We can all play our part in reducing the spread of these illnesses by taking note of the following tips:

1. Please carry on with good hygiene habits in the home, this includes handwashing for 20 seconds and using a tissue to catch coughs and sneezes.

2. It's fine to send your child to school with a minor cough or common cold. But if they have a high temperature keep them off school until it goes.

3. Stomach bugs spread rapidly around schools and nurseries. If you or your child have diarrhoea and vomiting – please carry on with handwashing with soap and warm water for 20 seconds, along with the following:

• Use bleach-based products to clean surfaces, this will help stop infections from spreading

• Don't prepare food for others if you have symptoms or for 48 hours after the symptoms stop

• Please avoid visiting people in hospitals or care homes

• Please don't return to work, school or nursery **until 48 hours after the symptoms** have stopped.

4. If you haven't already had the flu jab, please speak to your GP or your preferred pharmacy. All children aged 2 years (who have turned 2 years old before the 1 September 2024) and all 3-year-olds are eligible for the flu vaccine. If you haven't received your invite, please contact your GP.
