PTA Summer Fair

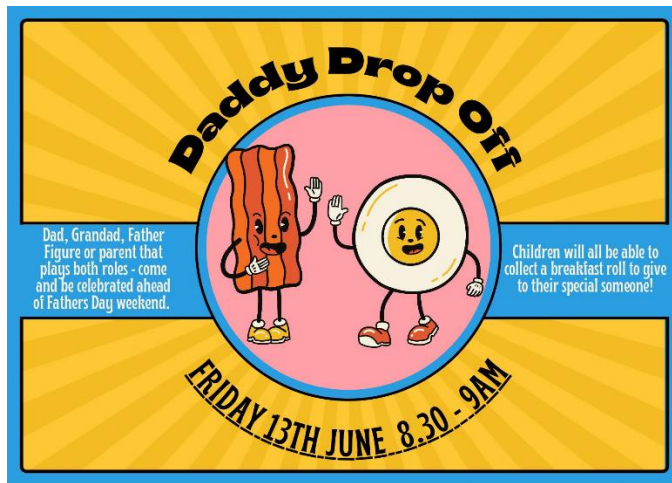
