

# Whole School Homework Project March/April 2024



As you know your children have their JASS books and some children have started to bring in their evidence to show us what they have been up to.

Your homework project this term (and over the Easter holidays) is to continue to work on your JASS book. We would recommend that you have at least two areas completed before the end of the Easter holidays and made a start on another area.

We have completed activities in school and before the end of this term will have offered the children the opportunity to complete the adventure section. This will be on our Sports and Activity Day on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2024.

The children need to include evidence within their books and this could take the form of photos, copies of any art work or writing, diary entry/journal about what they have done and remember to get any outside led sessions signed by the coach/group leader.

## **Homework activity**

We would like you spend some time with your child talking about their JASS books and deciding on an activity that you would like to complete. We will be allocating time after the Easter holidays for your children to share what they have done so far in their books.

Some examples of activities could include:

### **My Interests**

This is all about your children doing something new or improving a skill they already have. This should be something your child enjoys doing and can be learning a new skill, practicing a musical instrument or creating a research project and presentation about their favourite thing!

### **Get Active, Stay Active**

Logging physical activity they do at home including sports clubs. This could also include horse riding, walking the dogs, trampolining – anything that gets your child active.

### **Me and My World**

This is an opportunity for your child to help in the community. It could be charity fundraising, litter picking, visiting elderly relatives, helping in the garden or creating bird feeders.

### **Adventure**

We will cover this in school, but if your child is particularly adventurous you could include the evidence in this part.

These books are your children's record of what they have done, and they will not be able to achieve their award without the evidence.

Evidence could include: photographs, diary entries, letters, certificates or drawings, but we would also ask for you to sign off the evidence to show it has been completed.
